


The instructions explain how to find information using the **SpringerLink** database, providing researchers with access to millions of scientific documents from journals, books, series, protocols and reference works.

FINDING THE DATABASE:

- Go to the Mack Library website.
- Click on “Online Resources” and then
- Click on “S” to jump directly to the databases beginning with S.
- Scroll down to **SpringerLink** and click on the title. Select “Medicine” from the column to the left

SpringerLink is an integrated full-text database for journals, books, protocols, eReferences, and book series published by Springer. SpringerLink currently offers 2,580 fully peer-reviewed journals and 43,690 books online.

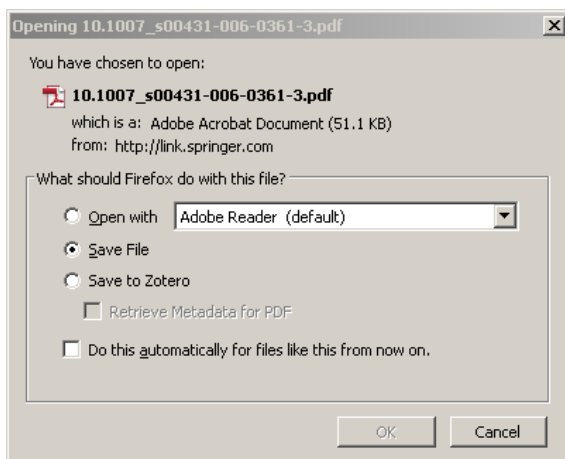
